SPRING COLLECTION

During June, we conducted our parish's annual Spring Collection, with the goal of raising \$135,000 to complete the fiscal year with a balanced operating budget.

As of June 30, we raised \$142,163 in the Spring Collection, surpassing our goal!

This is the largest amount of money raised in a Spring Collection in Saint Patrick's history, and a strong indication of the sacrificial generosity of our parishioners and the vitality of our parish.

MISSION APPEAL WEEKEND

As part of the annual Missionary Co-Operative Program, Father Gabriel Muteru, a priest of the Diocese of Nyeri, Kenya, will speak all Masses next weekend. Next weekend's second collection is our annual Missionary Co-Operative Appeal collection. That collection is taken up each year in every parish in the Archdiocese. The collective funds are then distributed by the Propagation of the Faith to a large number of missionary societies.

MASS IN VIETNAMESE

Beginning next weekend – Sunday, July 18 – we will resume weekly celebration of Mass in Vietnamese on Sundays at 3:00 pm. We are happy to welcome Father Peter Khanh, who has graciously agreed to assist our community in celebrating this weekly Mass.

WINDOW RESTORATION PROJECT

The second phase of the historic renovation of our church's 100 stained glass windows has begun and will last through mid-September. During this phase, the windows in the nave of the upper church, as well as several other windows, will be removed and prepared for shipment to Wisconsin for complete restoration. The windows that were removed last summer from the lower church will be installed, as well as a protective covering system for all external windows.

Because of the work currently being done in the upper church, all liturgies are now being celebrated in the lower church.

Our parishioners have responded with remarkable enthusiasm to this project through the **Inspiring Hope Campaign**. Many donors have acknowledged the importance of our faith community in their lives by naming their window renovation gifts "In Memory of . . ." or "Donated by . . .". 



RCIA

Are you an adult who has not yet been baptized and would like to explore the possibility of being baptized?

Are you an adult who was baptized in a non-Catholic Christian community and would be interested in entering full communion with the Catholic Church?

Are you an adult who was baptized as a child in the Catholic Church, never received further faith formation, and would like to pursue reception of the sacraments beyond baptism?

If any of these descriptions applies to you, it would be good for you to meet with a member of our parish's pastoral staff to discuss your possible participation in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults – the RCIA.

The RCIA is the process of spiritual and catechetical formation through which adults decide to become baptized or enter into full communion with the Catholic Church. At Saint Patrick's, we begin weekly RCIA gatherings each fall, with most adults receiving baptism and the other sacraments of initiation at Easter.

At this time, we encourage you to make an appointment for an initial discussion about your situation. To do so, please call Mrs. Joanne Morrow at the parish office.

El programa de RICA es un proceso de formación espiritual y catequética a través del cual los adultos pueden discernir si desean recibir los Sacramentos de Iniciación en la pascua. En San Patricio, comenzamos con reuniones semanales en el otoño. Si está interesado, hagan una cita para comenzar el proceso llamando a la oficina parroquial.


